### Creating Jump Links (Links to other parts of same page)

```

### Creating Internal Links to files in the same directory:

<a href="index.html"> Home </a>
```

### Creating Internal Links to files in one directory lower:

< a href="foldername/filename.html"> Refrigeration </a>
```

### Creating Internal Links to file in one directory higher:

<a href="../filename.html"> Words user sees </a>
```
